MAY 22, 2008

Beginning July 1, 2008, and each even-numbered year thereafter, each dollar amount in (A)(1) through (14), immediately before July 1, must be adjusted to reflect the change in the Southeastern Consumer Price Index, All Urban Consumers, as published by the Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, for the most recent year ending immediately before January 1 preceding July 1....No later than March 1 of each even-numbered year, the Economic Research Section shall publish in the State Register the dollar amounts that will become effective on July 1 of each even-numbered year.
